(Reuters) - California was the only U.S. state to register a higher percentage of its local gun sales to domestic purchasers in the first half of 2018 than in the first half of 2017, according to a Reuters analysis of National Instant Criminal Background Check System data. REUTERS/Brendan McDermid/File Photo The analysis found that from Jan. 1 through May 31, 2018, 34.4 percent of all firearm sales in California were domestic transactions, compared with 31.8 percent in the same period a year earlier. While California's total percentage of domestic firearm sales is only slightly higher than the national average of 32.7 percent, its share is greater than the combined 27.8 percent of the 23 other states and the District of Columbia that Reuters calculated. The analysis relied on firearm sales data released by the National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS) to the U.S. Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF). NICS is the federal government's primary system to report when individuals attempt to buy firearms, but it is not a comprehensive inventory of all firearm sales. The FBI said it does not track the location of firearms when they are transferred. While NICS data showed that the highest percentage of domestic firearm sales were in Florida, the state's total percentage was less than that of California, which had a 35.3 percent share. Although California had a higher percentage of domestic firearm sales than the other 23 states and the District of Columbia, it still ranked 29th in terms of the share of those sales that went to domestic purchasers, according to ATF data. The NICS data was not available for the remaining
